Today we are going to be thinking about direction.

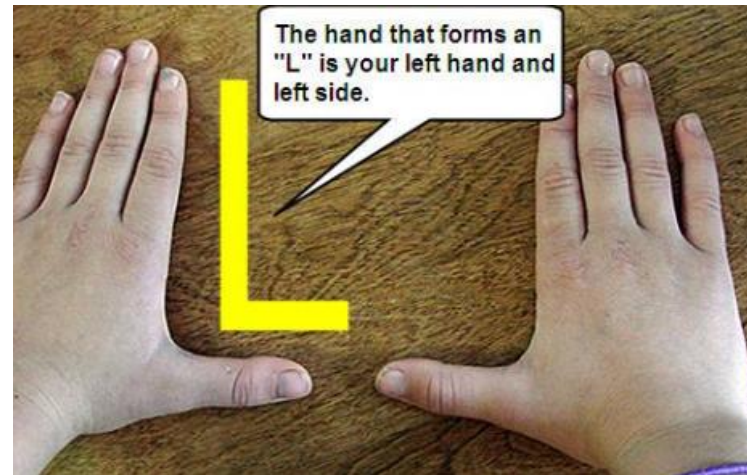
Warm up your brain and body:

- Can you jump forwards? Can you jump backwards?
- Hop forward 3 times and backwards 1 time
- Can you swing your arms in circles forwards and then backwards?

How did you know which way is which?

Thinking about forwards and backwards is easy, but left and right can be a bit more tricky.

Hold up both of your hands in front of you like this:



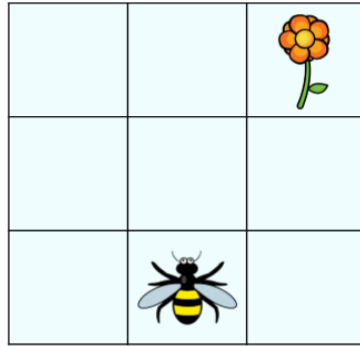
Can you see the L shape your left hand makes? L for left.

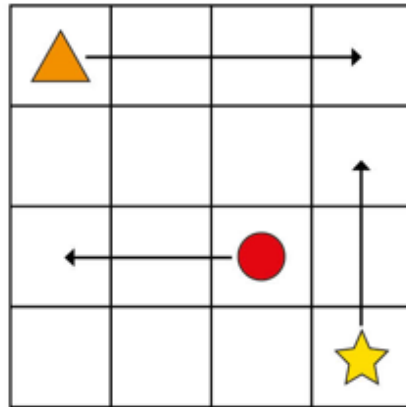

The bee needs to move forward 2 squares and left 1 square to get to the flower.

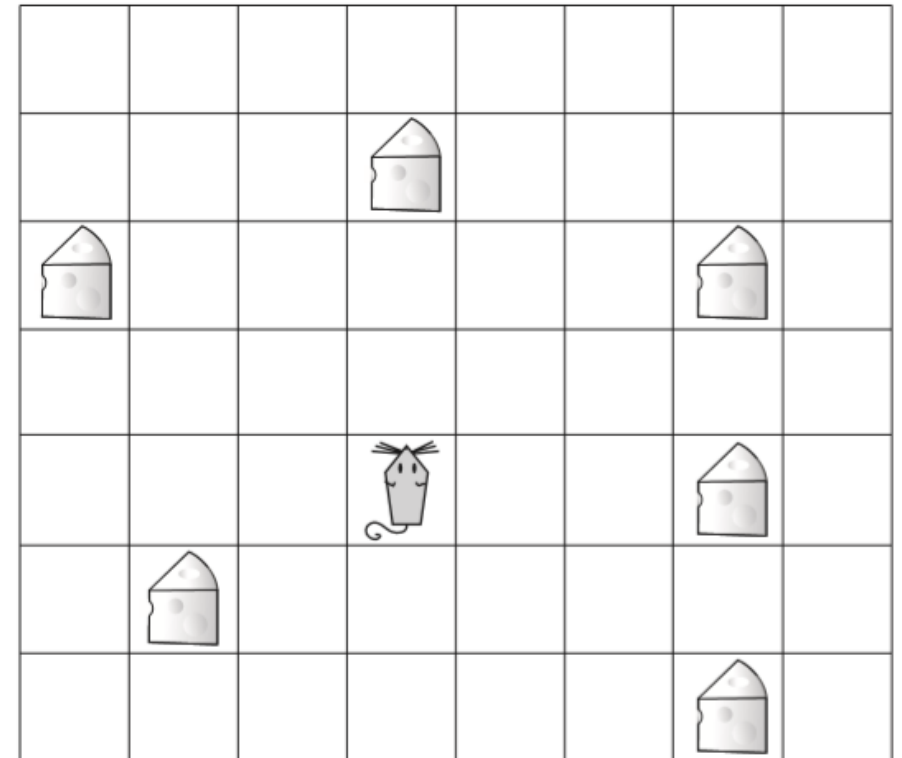
1 The arrows show where the shapes are moving to on the grid. Use the word bank to help you complete the sentences.
