Dear Parents,

To enhance and bring to life our KS2 pupils learning on this terms topic of "The struggle for Britain and especially York, by the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings" we are planning a visit to The Yorkshire Museum and The Jorvik Viking Centre in York on Monday 18th November. Pupils will take part in a "Struggle for York" workshop and get up close with what life was like in Anglo Saxon and Viking times.

All pupils will need to bring a packed lunch and drink from home (and ideally a backpack to carry it in) and must have a coat as they will be walking from one site to the other.

The total cost of the visit including transport and entry fees is £16.76 per pupil. We are therefore asking for a voluntary contribution of £8.50 per child towards these costs. No child will be excluded from the trip if a contribution is not made, but the trip may have to be cancelled if insufficient donations are received. All payments should be made via ParentPay please.

The bus will need to leave St Hilda's promptly at 8:45am and Hovingham at 9:00am to ensure we get to York on time, so please arrive at school a few minutes earlier than normal where possible.
