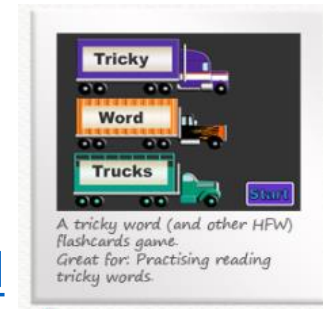

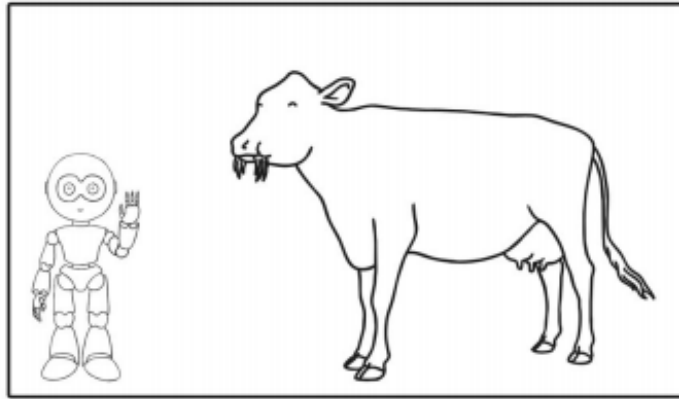


# Phonics

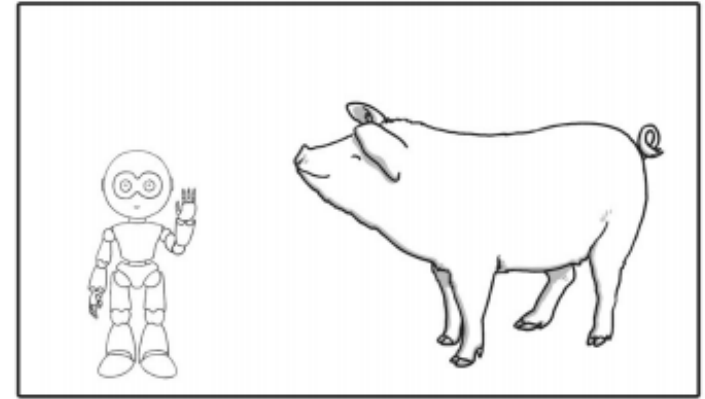
Can you read the first half of my farm story below (the second half will be on tomorrow's PowerPoint). Can you spot any of our tricky words in there?



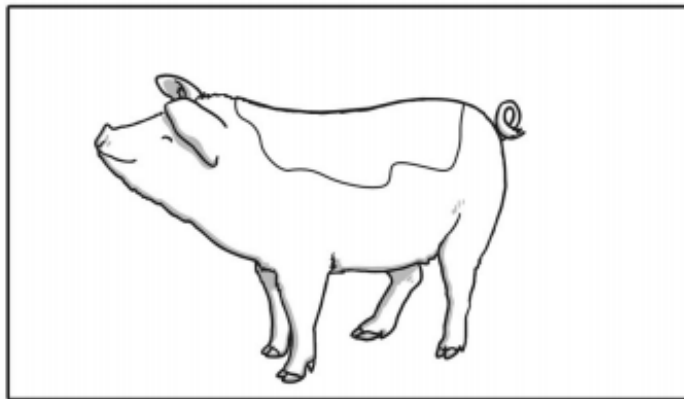
Rob the Robot went to the farm.



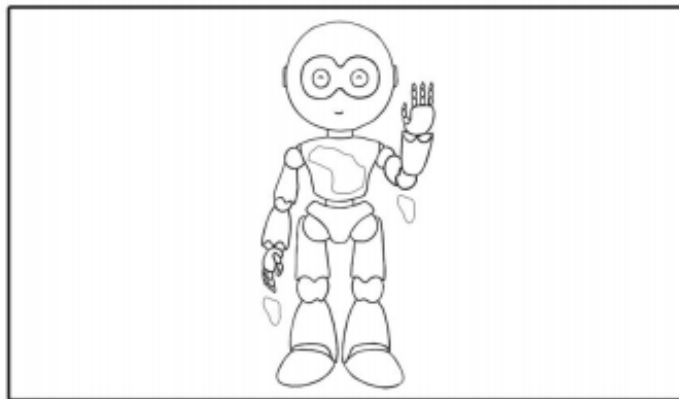
When he went in the barn,  
he saw some cows.



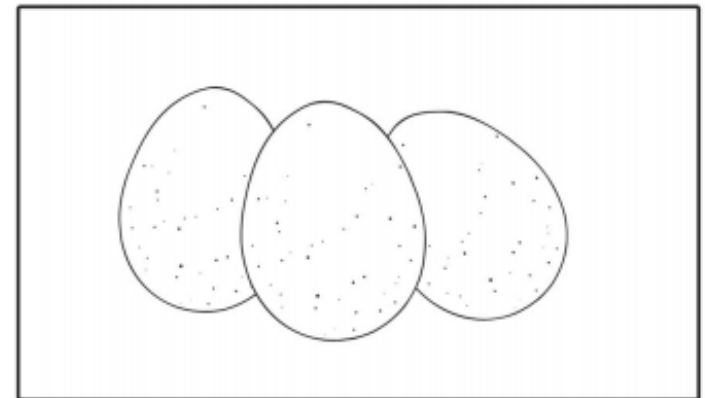
Next, he saw some pigs.
