Pro-Ride Cycling

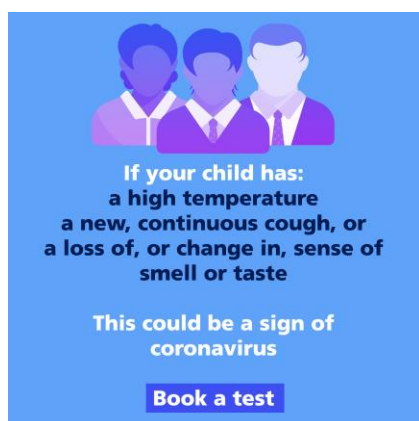
