### Governing Body

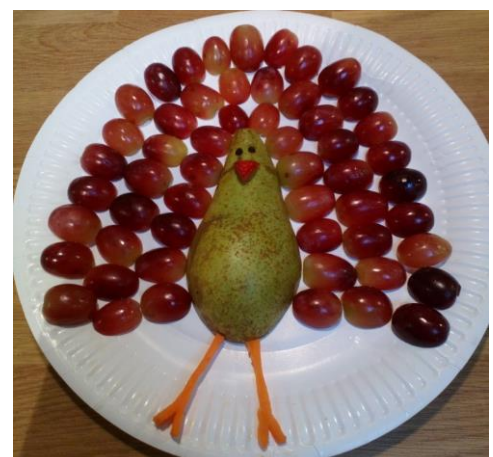
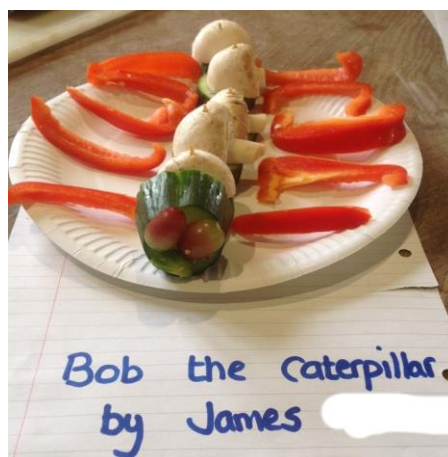
The full Governing Body are delighted to welcome Kim Colenso and Adrian Bond to the Governing Board.
