Message from Mr Pynn

Last week I attended training on Implementing an Effective Health and Mental Wellbeing curriculum in a primary school. It was really useful and gave lots of ideas to further develop our existing work in this area including helping families too. Next week, 3rd-9th February, is Children's Mental Health Week. A Top Tips for Parents resource, "[Find Your Brave](#)" is being shared with you and the children will talk about this in school too. What's "Find Your Brave" all about? Bravery comes in all shapes and sizes and is different for everyone. Bravery can be about sharing worries and asking for help, trying something new or pushing yourself outside your comfort zone. Helping our pupils in their Key Stage 2 History and Geography work

I've shared with pupils that parents can post suggestions and comments in the box too as I know that sometimes ideas come to mind and parents may prefer to quickly share them this way rather than by a conversation, phone call, email or letter.
