Nursery - Phonics

You need to play this game with other people.

Have an object, maybe a teddy, that one person can hide somewhere in a room. Then you need to sing 'la la la' louder as the other person comes to find the object. For example, if the person is getting close to the object you will sing loudly. If the person is moving away from the object you sing quietly.

Reception - Phonics

Today we are continuing with consonant and vowel sounds. Without peeking at yesterday's PowerPoint, can you write down all 5 vowel sounds? How many consonant sounds can you write down? There are 21! Can you count how many you wrote?

Can you think of a word that begins with each letter of the alphabet? E.g. a for apple, b for breakfast, c for cereal etc.

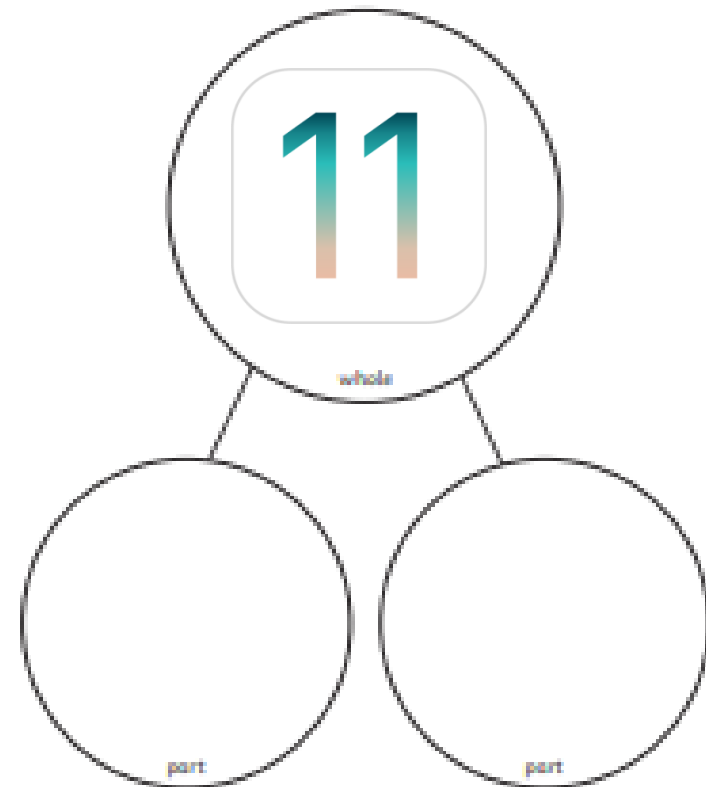
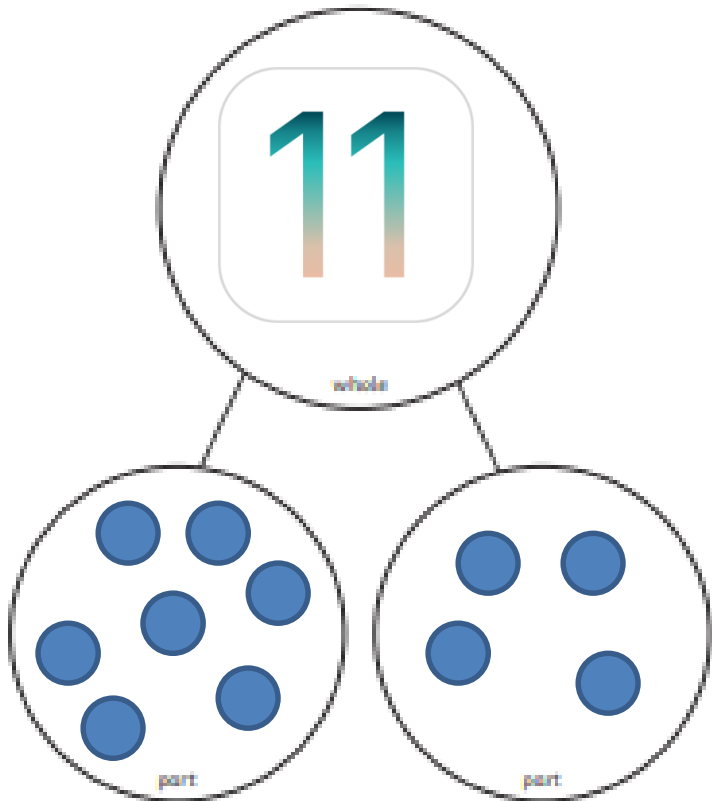
Teddy bear, teddy bear,
