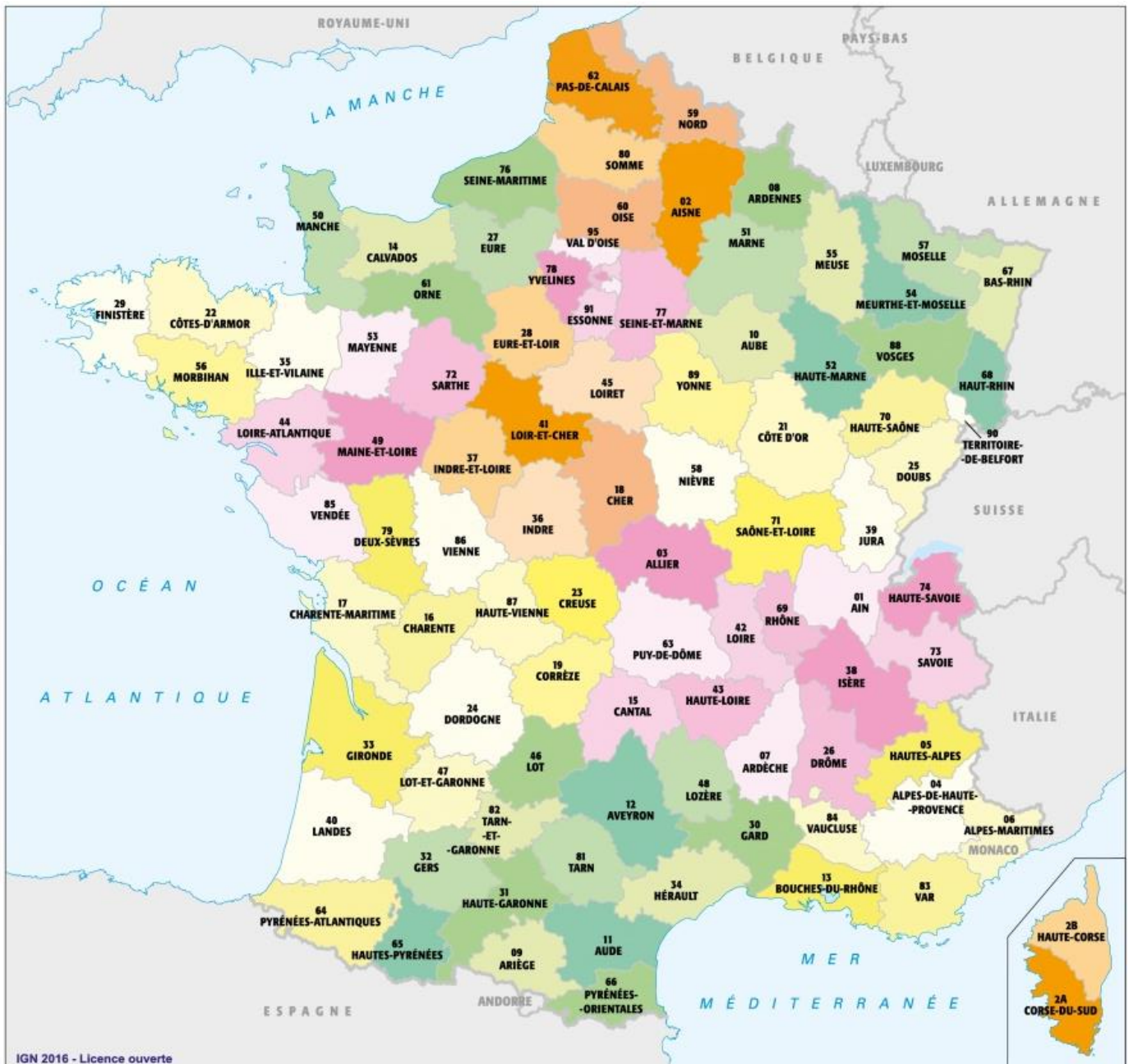
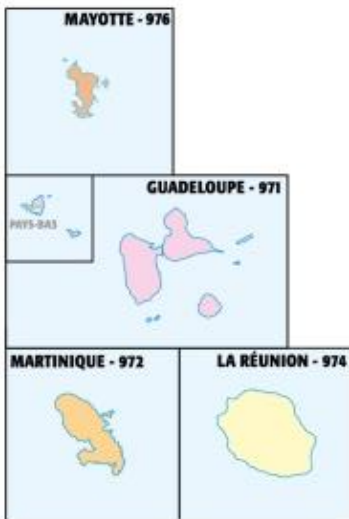
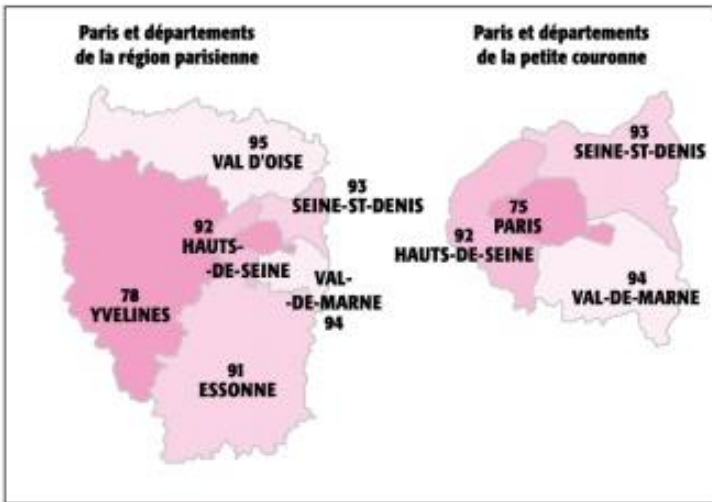


Year 6 French

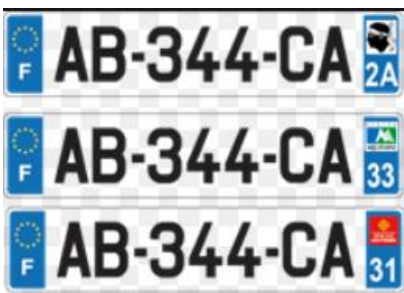
