Message from Mr Pynn

It is wonderful to be involved in so many partnerships with other schools. We are continuing to work with the English Hub to ensure our Phonics Provision meets the current expectations. Developing reading is so important as reading unlocks pupil ability to access the rest of the curriculum. We are also working with the Maths Hub as part of a Teacher Research Group. We continue to develop Maths Mastery so that all pupils can become even more confident and skilled in all areas of Maths. We are also working with several local schools as we develop the wider curriculum too, this includes reflecting on guidance from recent OFSTED research. Nut Allergies

You will be aware that we cannot have nuts in school in any form. Please can we ask that you have no nut products in lunch boxes or brought into school as snacks or treats. In addition, please ensure that hand soap, emollients and sunscreen products **do not contain nuts or nut oils including coconut**. This includes any creams applied before your child comes into school. Thank you for your cooperation.

Bringing Drinks into School

We have received advice from NYCC about pupils bringing drinks into school which we wanted to share with you: The school food standards state that water should be the default drink for every child and this would always be the recommendation for children during the school day. It appreciates that some children prefer to drink squash and making sure that the children stay hydrated is important, but water is the best option. Experience shows that the more it alone is offered the more readily children will accept it. Sugary or sweetened drinks often have no nutritional value, contribute to weight gain and can cause tooth decay.

Water is available for everyone throughout the school day. Please do speak with Mr Pynn if you would like to discuss this further.
