### School Dinner Charges in Oak Class (KS2)

### Nursery Lunch Club

From September, we are pleased to be able to offer a Nursery Lunch Club for those children who would like to stay. It will run from 12:00 midday to 1:00pm every day at a cost of **£3.40 per child per day**. This includes the cost of a freshly cooked meal, served in the school hall and supervision for the hour. It will be necessary to inform the class teacher each morning if your child is staying for lunch, so that they can notify the kitchen of exact numbers. Please ensure that payment is made promptly each week, via [ParentPay](#).
