- Announcements will be made via BBC Radio York (and details posted on their website) This is quite an unreliable method and I would therefore strongly urge you to check texts, emails and the school website.

Should bad weather occur once the children have arrived at school, then we will not send them home without first making sure there is somewhere safe for them to go.

- In the first instance we will send a text/email message and put a notice on the school website that the school is closing.
- We will telephone you if necessary to confirm details.
