Communication and Language

This term we will be continuing to develop our language and vocabulary skills through sharing stories and play based learning. We will also be focussing on our listening skills; not just listening to the grown ups but listening to each other!

Personal, Social and Emotional

This term we will be exploring our emotions and learning to understand the different emotions that we have and how they might look in ourselves and in others. We will also look at developing our resilience and perseverance skills.

Physical

Our weekly PE sessions continue to be delivered by Hawkes Health on a Friday morning 9:30-10:30 and all children take part. We will continue to develop our manipulation and control through using our gross and fine motor skills.

Literacy

Our literacy sessions are based around stories. This term we are sharing stories all about transport and Space. Reception will be working on their letter formation, sound and word recognition and working on writing captions.

Maths

We will learn about capacity and mass, height and length; as well as all things 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 including recognising, counting, ordering, sorting and the composition of each number! We will even be learning a little about time and shape. It's going to be a very busy term indeed!

Understanding the World

This term we will be looking at how we are all different in all sorts of ways and we will be investigating using lots of different materials in our provision!

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be listening and responding to music, singing and learning songs and rhymes and developing our imaginative skills

Reminders
