Vocabulary	<p>Plant-eating animals Meat-eating animals – animals who eat other animals Animals who eat plants and other animals Extension: carnivore, herbivore, omnivore Animal body parts: tail, wing, claw, fin, scales, feathers, fur, beak. Body parts: head, neck, arms, elbows, legs, knees, face, ears, eyes, eyebrows, eyelashes, nose, hair, mouth, tongue, toes, feet, fingers, wrists, knees Senses: tasting, smelling, seeing, touching, hearing</p>
