### Communication and Language

We will be continuing to develop our language and vocabulary skills through sharing stories and play based learning. We will also have a go at learning some simple poems and be able to perform them with some actions.

### Understanding the World

We will plant different seeds and be responsible for caring for our own plants. We will be thinking about the environment and how these can differ across the country and across the world.

### Maths

We will be consolidating our learning on all things 0-10 including addition and subtraction, number bonds and doubling and halving. We will also be introducing numbers 11-20 with the help of **NUMBERBLOCKS!**

### English

Lots of stories and poems will be shared as a whole group. This will support our understanding of stories and patterns/rhythm in language. Reception will be developing their writing skills, as they need to be able to write captions and sentences by the end of the year.

### Physical

Our weekly PE sessions delivered by Hawkes Health remains on a Friday morning. We will continue to develop our manipulation and control through using our gross and fine motor skills.

### Personal, Social and Emotional

We will be developing our skills in solving problems and controlling our emotions. Teamwork will also be a focus this term.

### Expressive Arts and Design

Lots of using our imaginative skills with play, props, music, dance and song!
