"On Wednesday, KS1 children joined Foston, Terrington and Stillington for a Great Fire of London day. We began by drawing designs for our 17th Century buildings before getting stuck in with building our "London" from a variety of boxes (thanks to all parents who donated), paper, straw, paint and glue. After lunch, we took our buildings onto Foston Field where we had a fire safety talk before buildings were placed in the centre of a fire pit. We set up a circle of housing further away from the centre to represent the housing on the other side of the river Thames. The children thoroughly enjoyed watching the buildings being set alight and watching them burn very quickly. This was a great visual perspective to support the learning that has taken place in History this half term. I was really proud of how our children got stuck in with their projects and got to work with some different children."

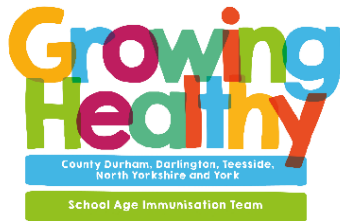
Parentpay

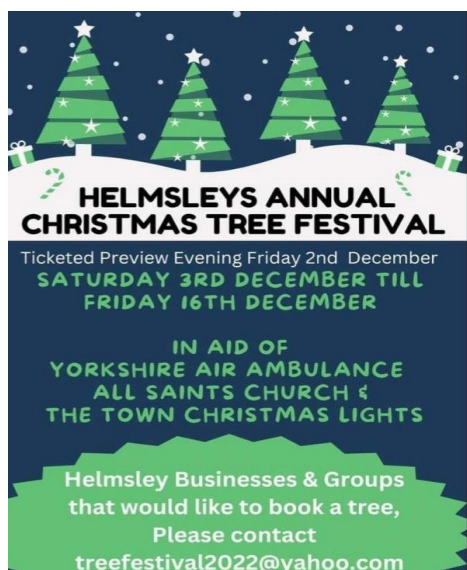
